
A message from Executive Director James Smith

ACEC Research Institute's Engineering Business Sentiment Survey Finds Extreme Optimism



The second quarterly ACEC Research

Institute Business Sentiment survey paints a starkly two-tone picture. Of the more than 600 member firm respondents, most are "extremely optimistic" about the current state of their firms and our industry, but at the same time, their "faith in the future of the U.S. economy dropped."

The survey uses a "Net Ratings" system, in which the negative responses are subtracted from the positive responses. A positive Net Rating indicates optimism and a negative one indicates pessimism.
